



By clicking either on the device name, or by opening the side menu and clicking View, you will be redirected to the Device/Devicepool View page.






Allocating A Devicepool



The devicepools allocated to a device will be shown in the table in the devicepools column. From here you will be able to remove allocated device pools by clicking on the 'x' button.



By clicking the + button in the devicepools column you can reveal dialog showing all the devicepools for that device.




Device Last Seen

Device Editing

In the options column, clicking on the 3 dots icon will open up a menu which contains 3 options (this can vary based on your user role). 'Edit' will open the Device Edit dialog. 'View' will route you to the Device/Devicepool View page. 'Delete' will remove the device from your account.
